LIFELONG LEARNER REGISTRATION AUDIT POLICY

Auditing a course allows Lifelong Learners the opportunity to attend course(s) without earning a grade or credit for the class.

- 1. Lifelong Learners are defined as being Utah residents, 62 years of age or older, and non-degree seeking.
- 2. Lifelong Learners registering to audit a class will pay \$10 per semester and are responsible for any course-related fees per the current fee schedule.
- 3. Some courses may not be open to audit Lifetime Learners because of classroom space limitations. Graduate courses are not eligible for the Lifelong Learner program.
- 4. Lifelong Learners are to seek both instructor(s) and departmental approval during the second week of class to audit a course.
- 5. Lifelong Learners auditing courses are expected to attend on a regular basis. Lifelong Learners may officially withdraw from an audited class according to the deadline defined by the Academic Calendar. Lifelong Learners that fail to attend class may be issued a "W" grade at the discretion of the instructor
- 6. Lifelong Learners are not eligible for Wildcards (WSU student ID cards) which provide access to most campus services and facilities such as the Swenson Gym, Health Center, etc.
